EDUCATION ASSISTANCE SCHEME

The St. Lucia Teachers' Credit Co-operative Education Assistance Scheme (EAS), hereafter known as the Scheme, is established to give persons who are members of the St. Lucia Teachers' Credit Co-operative Ltd. financial assistance when their children are entering secondary school for the first time.

Articles:

1. The EAS shall be funded from the Education Fund and from funds raised specifically for the scheme.
2. Each recipient shall receive an equal amount from the Scheme. The total amount to be distributed shall be proposed by the Board of Directors and ratified at the Annual General or Special General Meeting of the Society.
3. A member shall benefit from the scheme whether or not his/her child is the recipient of another award.
4. A member shall benefit from the scheme only once in respect of a particular child. If both parents of a child are members of the Society, only one entry can be made on behalf of that child. The assistance is given in the first year of Secondary education and is for one year only.
5. To be eligible to benefit from the scheme, a member must meet the following conditions:
 - a. Have a child who is entering a recognized secondary school in St. Lucia at the age of 11+ years for the first time.
 - b. Have been a member of the Society for at least six months by the deadline date for application.
 - c. Have at least five hundred dollars (\$500.00) in shares/SSSA in the Society by the deadline date for application.
 - d. Complete the necessary application form and have it returned to the Board before the deadline date declared by the Board.
6. The decision of the Board shall be final with regards to the selection of recipients and the distribution of the funds allocated to the scheme.
7. Proof of registration at a secondary school must be given at collection of the award.
8. Any report of fraud shall be placed before a disciplinary committee set up by the Board. The committee shall investigate the matter and make recommendations to the Board.
